FORTRESS BRITAIN

Come and visit forts and castles from Roman Fort and city walls, castles and the RAF Bunker from where the Battle of Britain was controlled

During a series of day visits, we will explore a wide range of amazing places that represent a great sweep of British history from the Iron Age to the 20th Century. We will visit some of the most remarkable military structures in the world! These include: the biggest Iron Age fort in Europe, the most complete Roman Fort outside of Italy (really very impressive), the remains of a walled Roman city (with amphitheatre), Norman and Tudor castles, a mighty Victorian fortress (with lots of tunnels) and an underground RAF command centre from where the Battle of Britain was controlled. Who built these places and why? On the last day, we will visit a beach where the students will complete the trip by building sand models of the fortifications they have explored. The exact itinerary may be subject to variation.
